PPC Highlights

Established multi-stakeholder country partnership to enhance coordination

Institutionalized DRM training within the National Center for Disaster Management (NCDM) for scale-up and scale-out

Expanded Emergency Assessment Teams (EAT) to support NCDM during flood assessments for joint action during the 2021 floods

Engaged and broadened the scope of the private sector for more comprehensive policies that include the impacts and challenges on micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) and the overall sector through policy dialogues

Strengthened flood preparedness of the private sector through the Early Warning 1294 System (EWS 1294)

Strengthening understanding of gender-sensitive approaches by introducing guidelines in local language

Integrated the private sector in inter-agency mechanisms such as the Humanitarian Response Forum
