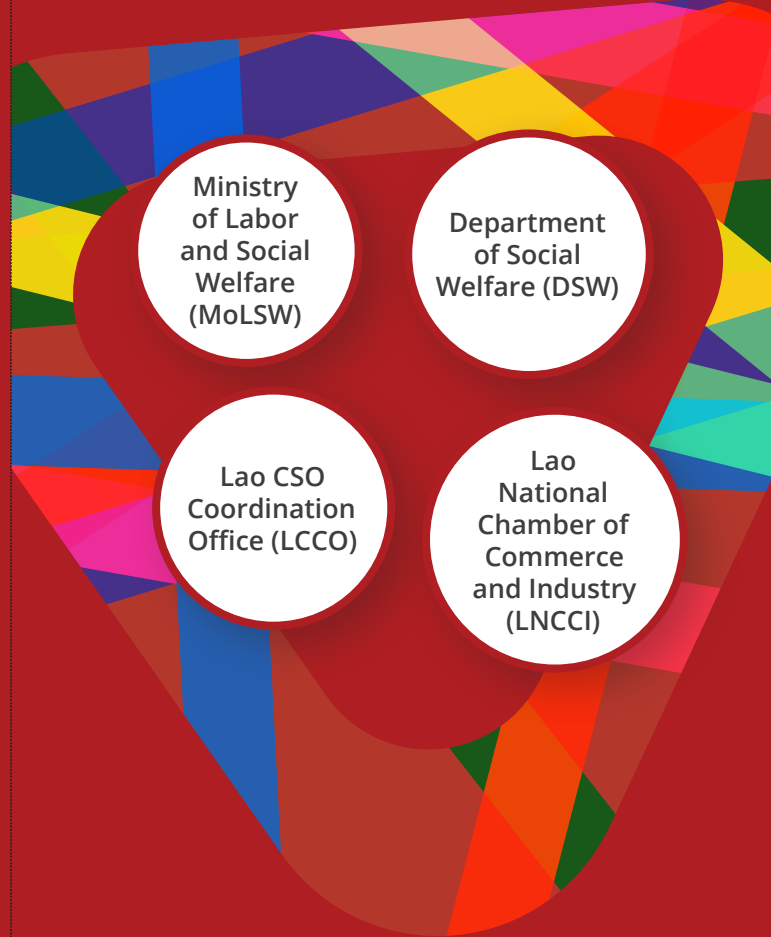

## Highlights

The Terms of Reference (ToR) for multi-stakeholder cooperation on disaster preparedness and response coordination platform through the Lao Disaster Preparedness Partnership (LDPP) has been developed and is now under approval process from the Chair of the National Disaster Management Committee, Minister of Ministry of National Defense

The platform would be co-chaired by representatives from the government, CSOs and the private sector

Developed a DRM training manual and curriculum in local language for training National and Sub- national Disaster Management Committees and representatives from the private sector and CSOs.

Adapted and contextualized Institutional Capacity Assessment Tools on Compliance to the Core Humanitarian Standards and provided orientation to private sector and CSO representatives

Contextualized Business Resilience Module and provided orientation to government officers, CSOs and private sector

Promoted learning and facilitated the south-south knowledge management and exchange

Increased knowledge and awareness of partners on multi stakeholder approach to promote localization
