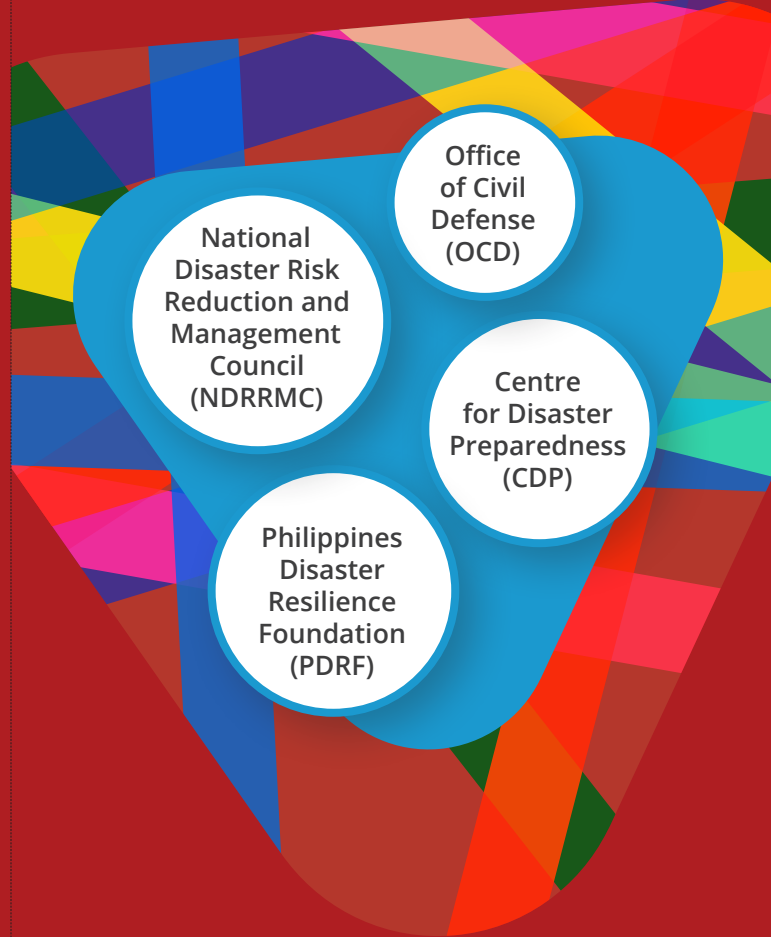

## PhilPrep Highlights

Established a multi-stakeholder country partnership to enhance coordination

Conducted joint tripartite humanitarian response initiatives related to the Taal Volcano eruption and Typhoon Rai (Odette), including the provision of mental health and psychosocial support services (MHPSS) for affected populations

Performed damage needs and capacity assessment to consolidate and coordinate resources for Typhoon Rai (Odette) response

Advanced the localization agenda across 50 local organizations from key sectors through coordination and learning events such as the National Humanitarian Stakeholders' Summits in 2019 and 2021

Strengthened the institutional capacity of vulnerable sectors by initiating community-based disaster risk reduction and management (CBDRRM) as well as adaptive and flexible programming in humanitarian action (AFPHA)

Improved knowledge of local actors on right-based humanitarian response

Supported the strengthening of resilience of micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) through collaboration with the National MSME Resilience Core Group (RCG)

Developed key guidelines and tools MSMEs toward business resilience such as the MSME Disaster Risks and Needs Assessment Tool as well as the MSME BCP Capability and Readiness Assessment Checklist

Enhanced integration of humanitarian standards through training, conduct of the People's Conference on Humanitarian Standards, and development of the Private Sector-Adapted Core Humanitarian Standard (CHS) Guide

Supported local innovations in addressing issues related to disasters and climate change through collaboration with the Pinnovation Academy

Raised public awareness on key DRM issues through the conduct of campaigns and the development of informative toolkits, guidelines, and knowledge products
