A patient with clinical signs of severe pneumonia or severe acute respiratory infection

A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage or with septic shock.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities may be admitted to a treatment facility. Moderate, severe or critical cases must be admitted to a health facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities. Non-severe pneumonia: fever, cough, dyspnea or respiratory rate of 21-30 breaths/minute, oxygen saturation more than 92% at room air for adults, and cough or difficulty in breathing and fast breathing or chest indrawing for children

Severe pneumonia: fever, cough, dyspnea or respiratory rate of more than 30 breaths/minute, oxygen saturation less than or equal to 92% at room air for adults, central cyanosis, oxygen saturation less than 90%, fast breathing, very severe chest indrawing for children



CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (NATIONWIDE)




CONFIRMED DEATHS BY DATE OF DEATH (NATIONWIDE)






Time-varying Reproduction number



The time-varying **reproduction number** (R_{*}) indicates the possible number of people being infected by a sick person, at a specific time with control measures in place.

IMPORTANT NOTE. The reproduction number is measured using symptom onset, we do not include in the interpretation the past 14-16 days given the time between symptoms, health seeking, testing, and reporting. When interpreting the reproduction number keep in mind that it is a l<mark>agging indicator (that is, it provides a snapshot of the situation two weeks ago)</mark>. Please do not expect this number to change daily.

- The reproduction number (R₂) was around 2 early on in the outbreak. This meant that each confirmed person with COVID was infecting 2 other people.
- Based on the latest data, we are 95 percent confident that $R_{\star} = 0.96 \pm 0.02$, which means each infected individual was infecting an average of 0.96 other persons around two weeks ago.
- Lowering this value is made possible through efforts such as social distancing, wearing of PPE, and other means to stop the spread of the virus.
- The goal is for R, to be less than 1, which would mean that, on average, an infected person is infecting less than one person, eventually stopping the transmission of COVID-19.


UTILIZATION OF COVID-19 BEDS





RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of November 20, 2020

- DOH recorded **31,805 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (26,948; 84.7%) while **1,440 patients** are in **critical condition** (4.5%).
- DOH recorded **11,992 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of these, **11,660** (97.2%) have recovered, 75 (0.6%) have died and 257 (2.1%) were active cases. Of these active cases, 120 (46.7%) were mild cases, 105 (40.9%) were asymptomatic, 18 (7.0%) in severe condition, 11 (4.3%) in critical condition and 3 (1.2%) in moderate condition.
- A total of **611,910 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** have arrived in the country (Land-based: 351,694; Sea-based: 258,230; and Transferees from Sabah 1,986). Of these, **608,099 were released from facility quarantine** (Land-based: 349,335; Sea-based: 256,778; and Sabah: 1,986). Among the ROFs, **10,457 were confirmed COVID-19 patients** (Land-based: 6,564; Sea-based: 3,893). Among these, 342 are currently admitted, 10,069 have already recovered; and 6 have died.
- A total of 2,637 cases of Filipinos staying overseas who have been tested positive for COVID-19 has been reported to the Department of Health through the Bureau of International Health Cooperation and the Epidemiology Bureau as the Philippines' Focal Point for International Health Regulations. This represents 22% of the total 11,558 confirmed cases reported by the Department of Foreign Affairs through the submissions of the Philippine Foreign Service Posts across the world. On the other hand, there are 510 Foreign Nationals who have been confirmed of having COVID-19 in the Philippines.
- There are **10,277 HRH** hired out of the 16,325 approved slots for emergency hiring in **370** health facilities. Of these, 37.7% were hired in DOH hospitals, 16.6% in Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility, 15.6% in COVID-19 diagnostic facility, 13.3% in LGU and other hospitals, 6.7% in COVID-19 referral facility, 3.5% in Epidemiology and Surveillance Units, 2.9% in private health facilities, 2.4% in Mega LIGTAS COVID-19 Centers, and 1.3% for other healthcare facilities.
