

Breakdown of Active Cases



A patient with an RT-PCR confirmed case of COVID-19 without symptoms.



A patient with mild symptoms and stable vital signs. Unless the patient belongs to high-risk subgroups or has comorbidities, they are often not admitted to a treatment facility.



A patient with difficulty breathing, altered mental status, considered high-risk or in need of hospital care.



A patient with impending or ongoing respiratory failure, in need of mechanical ventilation, or with evidence of end-organ damage.

Note. A person who is classified as having a mild case of COVID-19 but is considered high-risk due to age or the presence of comorbidities must be admitted to a treatment facility. Severe or critical cases must be admitted to a treatment facility, regardless of inclusion in high-risk subgroups or presence of comorbidities.





CONFIRMED DEATHS BY DATE OF DEATH (NATIONWIDE)




1. Bars with dark green colors indicate the actual date of onset or date of death for newly-reported cases.



RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of September 4, 2020

- DOH recorded **67,786 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (61,472; 90.7%) while **963 patients** are in **critical condition** (1.4%).
- DOH recorded **7,299 health care workers** positive for COVID-19. Of these, **6,597** (90.4%) have recovered, 40 (0.5%) have died and 662 (9.1%) were active cases. Of these active cases, 390 (58.9%) were mild cases, 268 (40.5%) were asymptomatic, 2 (0.3%) in severe condition and 2 (0.3%) in critical condition.
- A total of 315,643 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) have arrived in the country (Land-based: 166,725; Sea-based: 147,727; and Transferees from Sabah 1,191). Of these, 309,061 were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 162,982; Sea-based: 144,888; and Sabah: 1,191). Among the ROFs, 6,990 were confirmed COVID-19 patients (Land-based: 3,685; Sea-based: 3,305). Among these, 914 are currently admitted, 5,902 have already recovered; and 5 have died.
- There are **7,575 HRH hired** out of the **10,136 approved slots for emergency hiring** in 313 health facilities. Of these, 43.6% were hired in DOH hospitals, 17.2% in COVID-19 diagnostic facility, 14.4% in Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility, 12.3% in LGU and other hospitals, 5.8% in COVID-19 referral facility, 2.6% in Mega LIGTAS COVID-19 Centers, 2.0% in private health facilities, 0.4% in Epidemiology and Surveillance Units, and 1.1% for other healthcare facilities.
- A total of 1,992 cases of Filipinos staying overseas who have been tested positive for COVID-19 has been reported to the Department of Health through the Bureau of International Health Cooperation and the Epidemiology Bureau as the Philippines' Focal Point for International Health Regulations. This represents 19% of the total 10,113 confirmed cases reported by the Department of Foreign Affairs through the submissions of the Philippine Foreign Service Posts across the world. On the other hand, there are 250 Foreign Nationals who have been confirmed of having COVID-19 in the Philippines.
