Conducted by Suan Dusit Poll during 1-4 July 2020
from 1,109 representative samples

THE WORRY OF THE PUBLIC ON THE COVID-19 SITUATION, AFTER THAILAND HAS HAD NO NEW CASES OVER 30 DAYS

- 52.93% Less worried
- 29.94% Same as before
- 12.44% Not worried
- 4.69% More worried



WHEN THAILAND CAN COME BACK TO NORMAL?



- 39.40% By the end of the year 2020
- 27.95% By mid-2021
- 23.90% By the end of the year 2021
- 8.75% Not sure. Difficult to predict

HOW THE PUBLIC CAN HELP TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF THE VIRUS?

- 94.77% Wear a face mask
- 88.19% Frequently wash hands
- 81.24% Social distancing
- 79.80% Take care of their health
- 76.92% Avoid visiting crowded places



AFTER THE COVID-19 SITUATION GETS BETTER, WHAT KIND OF ACTION THE PUBLIC WANTS THE GOVERNMENT TO DO?

- 77.55% Keep aware of the situation strictly
- 71.78% Continue to put up the help measures
- 69.43% Build skills and careers
- 65.64% Help unemployed persons
- 57.26% Support domestic tourism
