

# Restriction Measures for Traveling on Domestic Flights

## Chiang Mai International Airport

- Arriving passengers must complete their information for tracking.
- Receive instructions and guideline documents for observing their symptoms during the 14-day local quarantine.
- Foreign passengers must be quarantined at the place designated by the provincial authorities for 14 days at their own cost.

## Phuket International Airport

The airport has now suspended its operations until 15 May 2020, at 23.59 hr, on the order of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand.

## Suvarnabhumi Airport, Don Muang Airport, and Hat Yai Airport

No additional restrictions for operating or traveling by aircraft.



# Restriction Measures for Traveling on Domestic Flights

Mae Fah Luang - Chiang Rai International Airport

- Arriving passengers must complete their information for tracking through QR code.
- If the passengers were domiciled and conducted daily life in Bangkok and its vicinity, or in Phuket, or in four southern border provinces more than one day, they must report themselves to the local disease control officers after arriving at their residence for 14 days of home quarantine.
- Passengers who travel from Bangkok but don't have a domicile history there, or who travel to Bangkok only in order to travel to another province on that day should self-quarantine in their residence for 14 days without reporting to officers. If there is fever or abnormal symptoms under the criteria for disease investigation, they must go see a doctor at the nearest hospital.
- Passengers who travel from Phuket must report themselves at Wiang Inn Riverside Resort and be in local quarantine for 14 days.
