Instructions for observation



at residence









Stop classes, working or other outside activities



Close

mouth and nose with tissue paper regularly when sneezing or coughing



Do not

share your personal belongings and separate them from others



Wear

hygiene or face mask and maintain a distance of more than 1 meter



Separate bedrooms



Clean

clothes and other items frequently



Wash

your hands frequently with soap and water



Throw

your mask and used tissue paper correctly in a plastic bag and tie tightly.

Make sure to clean your hands immediately after.

* For emergency cases, you must receive permission from an officer before leaving

Monitor your symptoms

- Check your body temperature every day
- Observe your fever 37.5°C and respiratory symptoms (cough, sore throat, shortness of breath)



- Record your health status every day in the report system
- If you have a fever accompanied by at least one of the symptoms, you are to inform of disease control officer immediately
