- Establish Transition Working Group to link humanitarian and development work being undertaken by the stakeholders
- Conduct meetings for agreement on common standards for 'Coordination Capacity' and to address the gaps existing by NDMA, PDMA, UN agencies, PHF, NHN, Academia, Federation of Pakistan Chamber of Commerce and Industry and PEMRA
- Organize meetings with the donor agencies to fund and support adapted, context-relevant coordination mechanisms
- Conduct research to document potential models for coordination, particularly at subnational and inter-Cluster level, which includes case study examples by Academia
- Conduct regular coordination architecture reviews to ensure coordination mechanisms are most appropriate for evolving
- contexts Develop contingency plans at national and sub-national levels
- Consultation meetings with private sector for investments in emergency preparedness and making agreements on Pre-positioning of supplies

- Conduct trainings for government staff and LHOs on CHS and Sphere Minimum Standards.
- Conduct small scale studies to explore possibilities of accreditation for the Certificates of Competency with universities or professional bodies to create a ladder of opportunity for humanitarian workers to achieve University Certificates/Diplomas through accumulation and transfer of Credits
- Conduct trainings for LNGOs/CSOs, media and corporate sector on competencies required and knowledge for effective humanitarian coordination

- Conduct research on knowledge management Systems for emergency preparedness and response
- Develop awareness and outreach material for corporate sector on its role in emergency preparedness and response
- Convene and organize advocacy events for Higher Education Commission (HEC) and Higher Education Department (HED) to integrate disaster risk management and humanitarian leadership into the university curricula






